"The pre-disaster education guided the pupils at primary and junior high schools in Ishinomaki-city (one of the cities completely washed away) to safety during the tsunami. Miszuhama area in Ishinomaki has a total of 380 residents and about 130 households. However, only one person died and eight remain missing.
